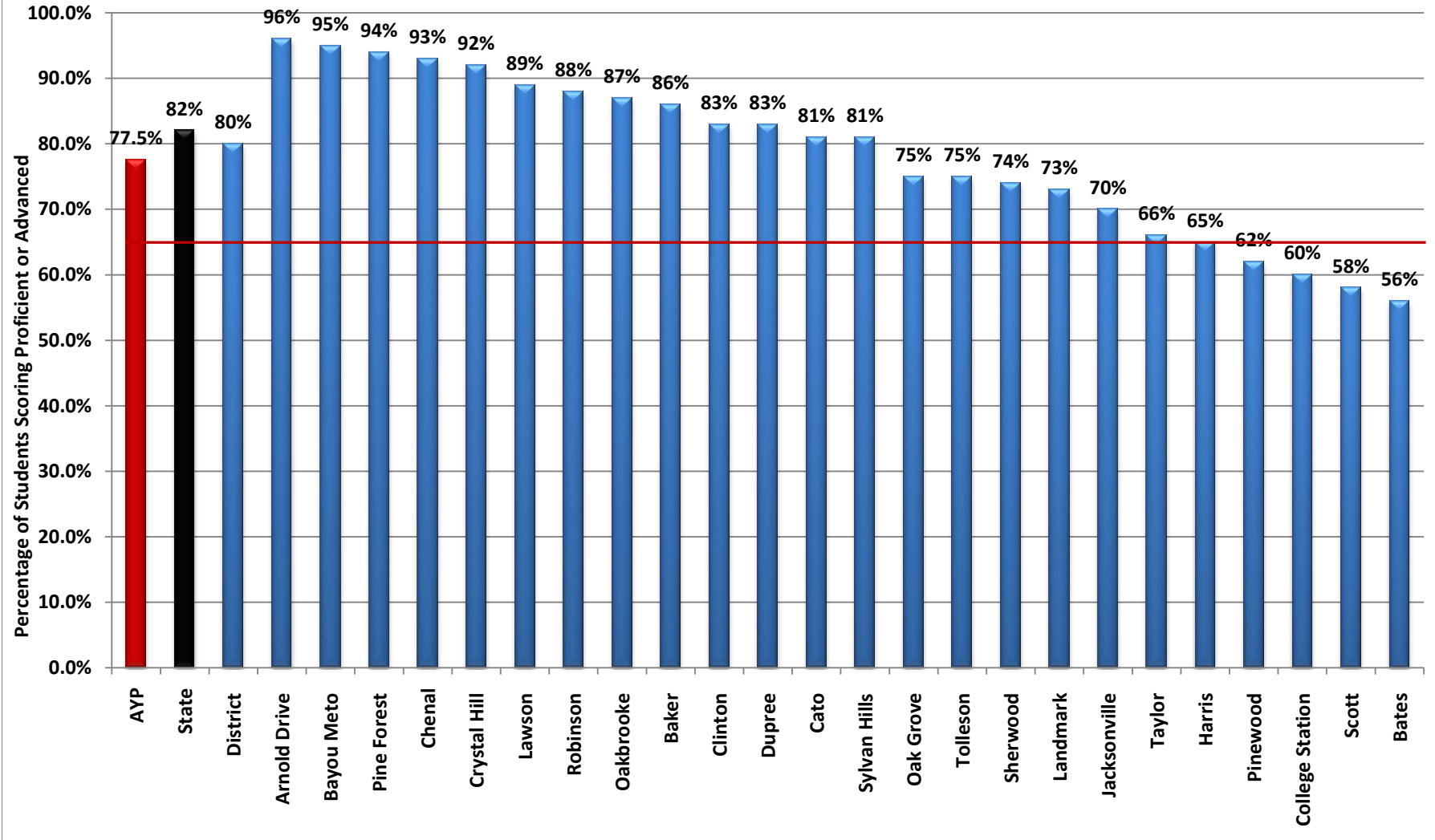

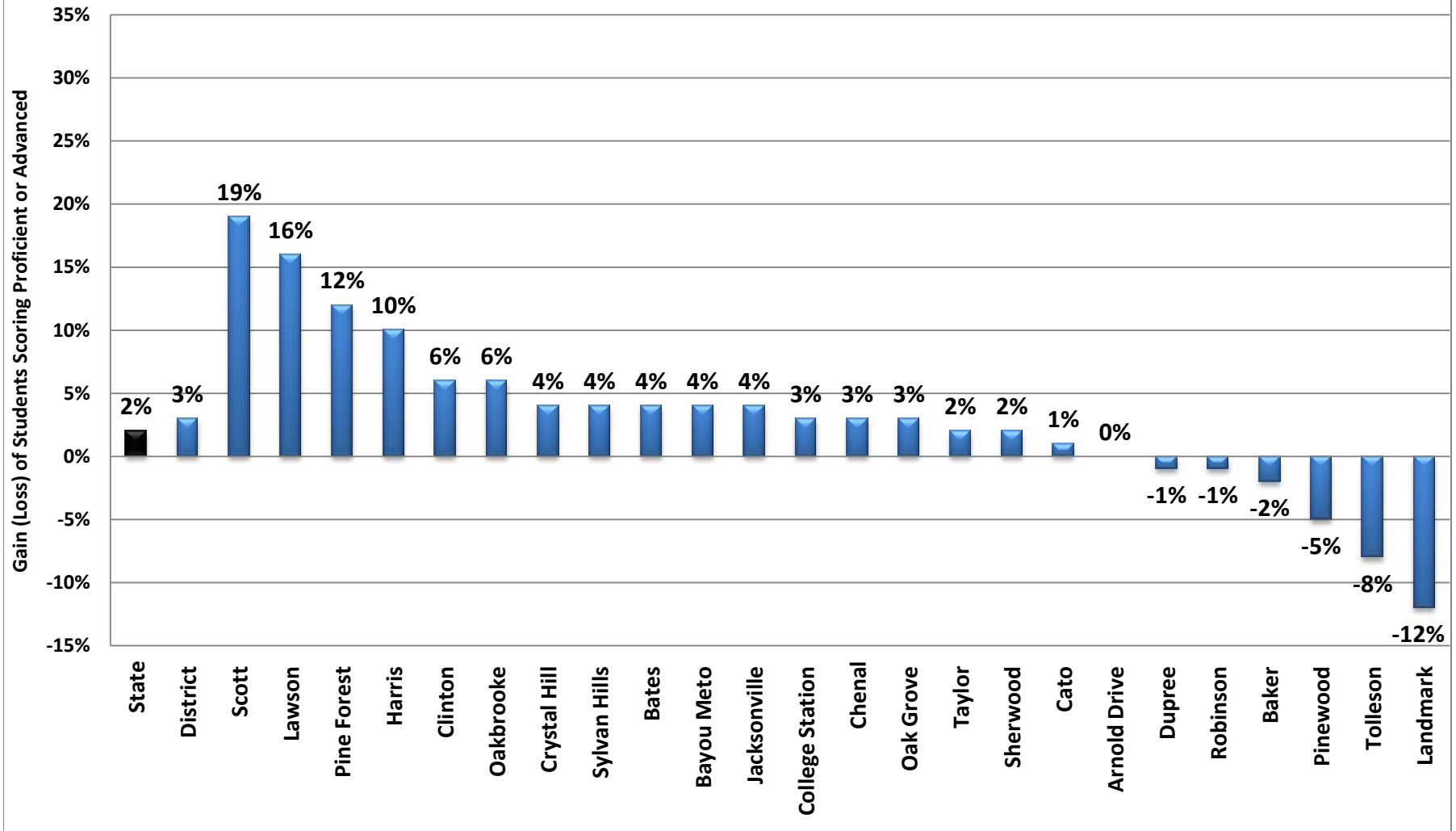

PCSSD Comparisons of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced 4th Grade Mathematics Combined Population Spring 2011



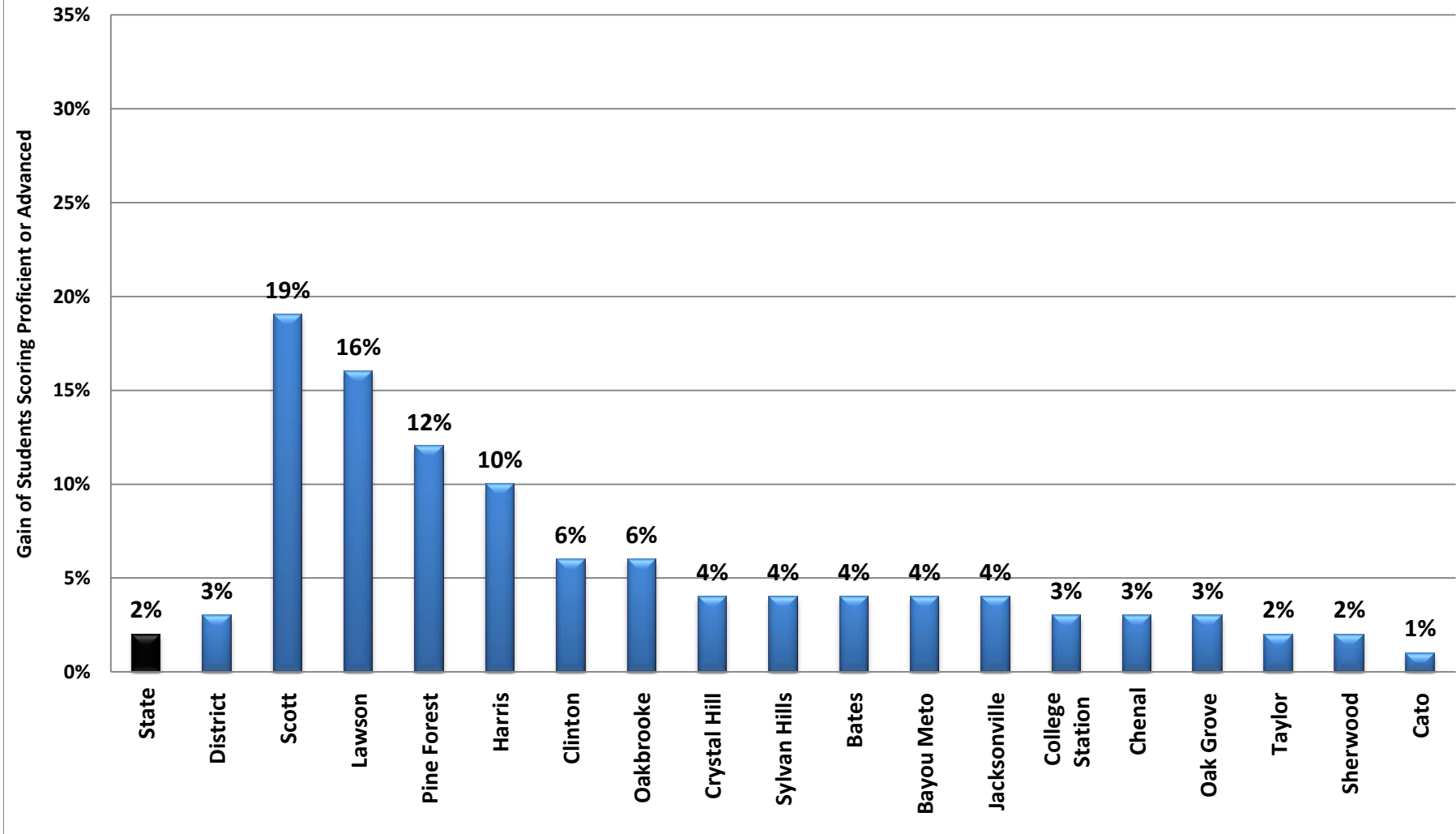

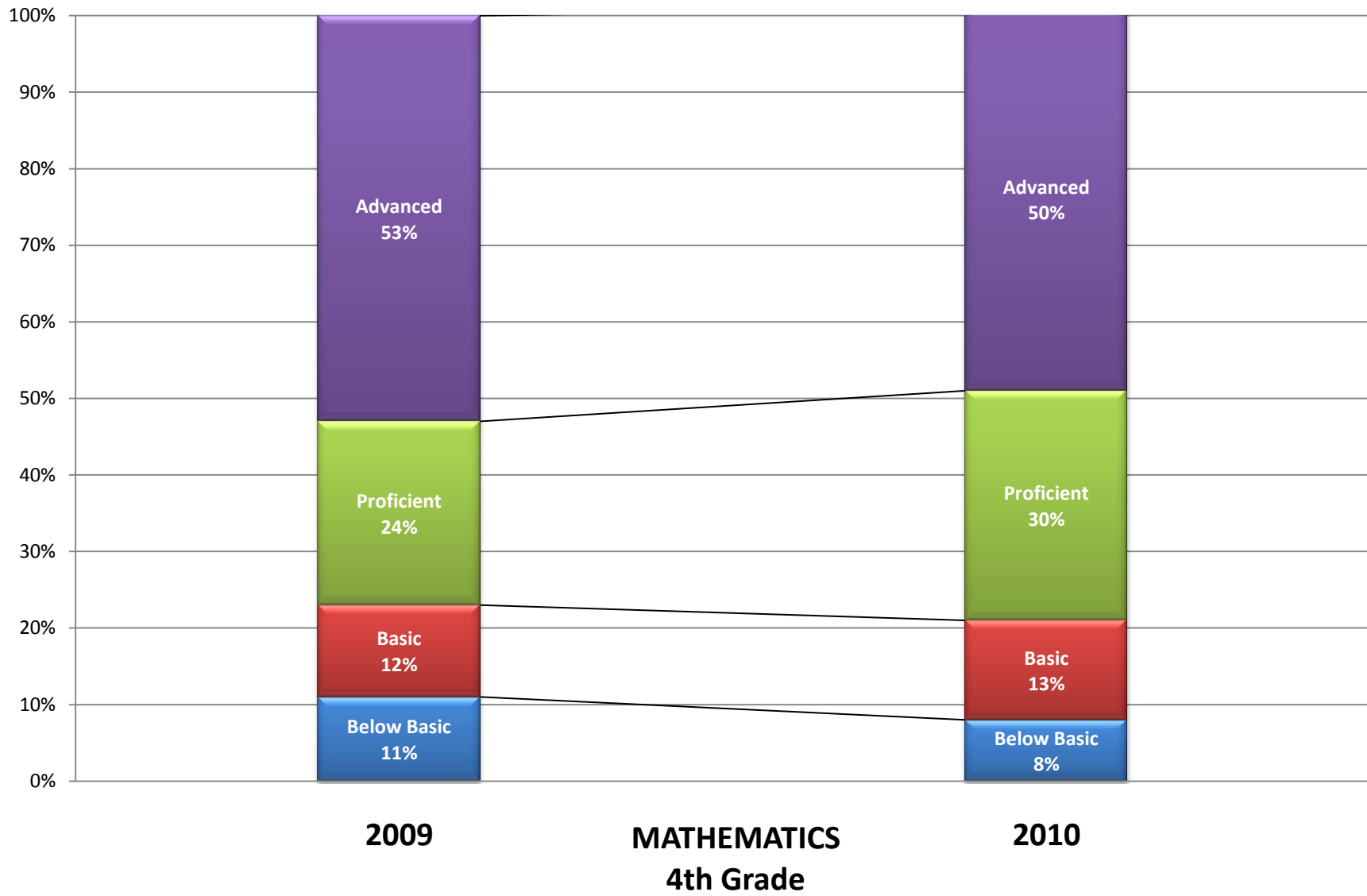

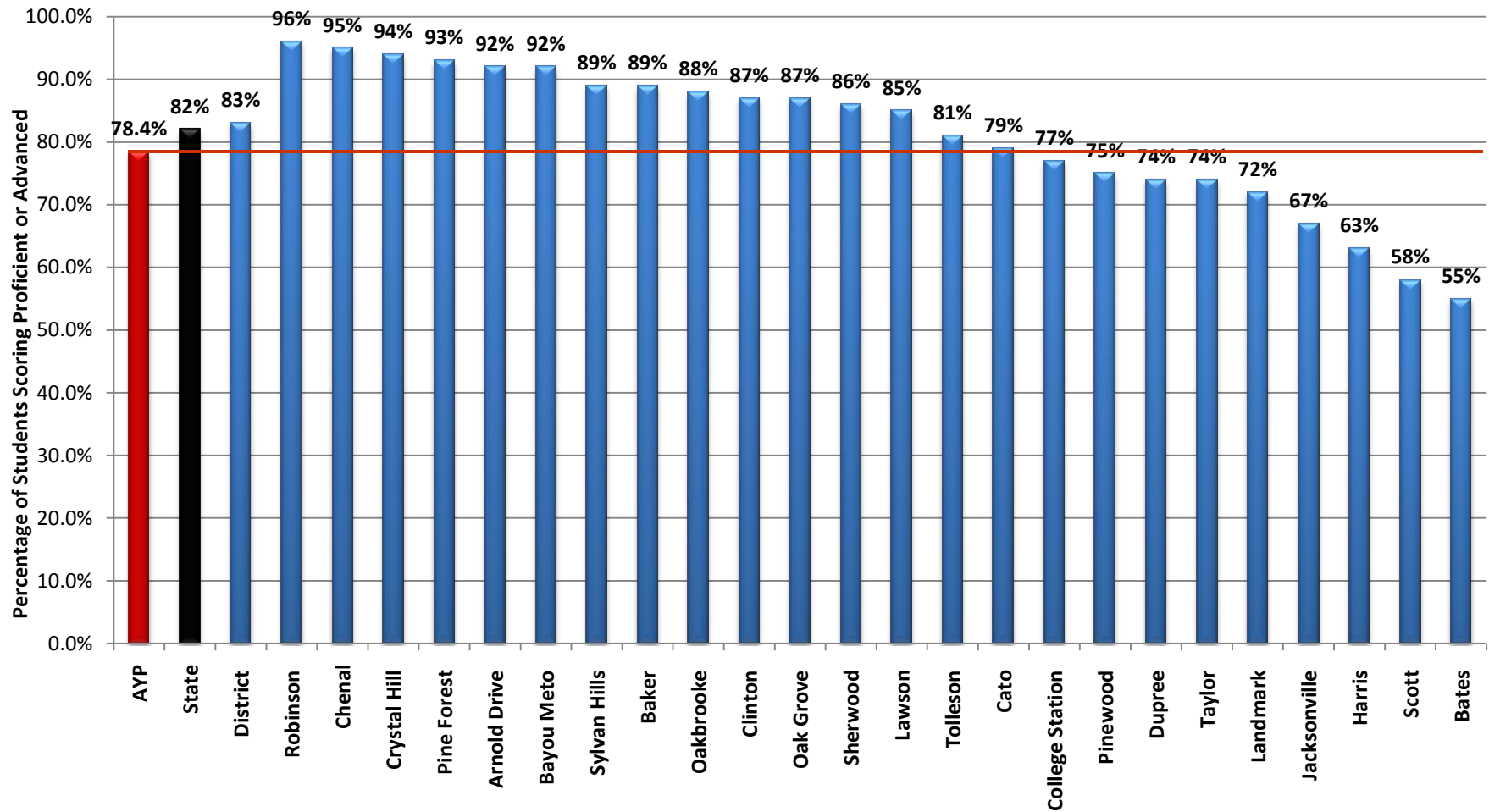

Combined Population Benchmark Exams Spring 2011 Compared to Spring 2010**



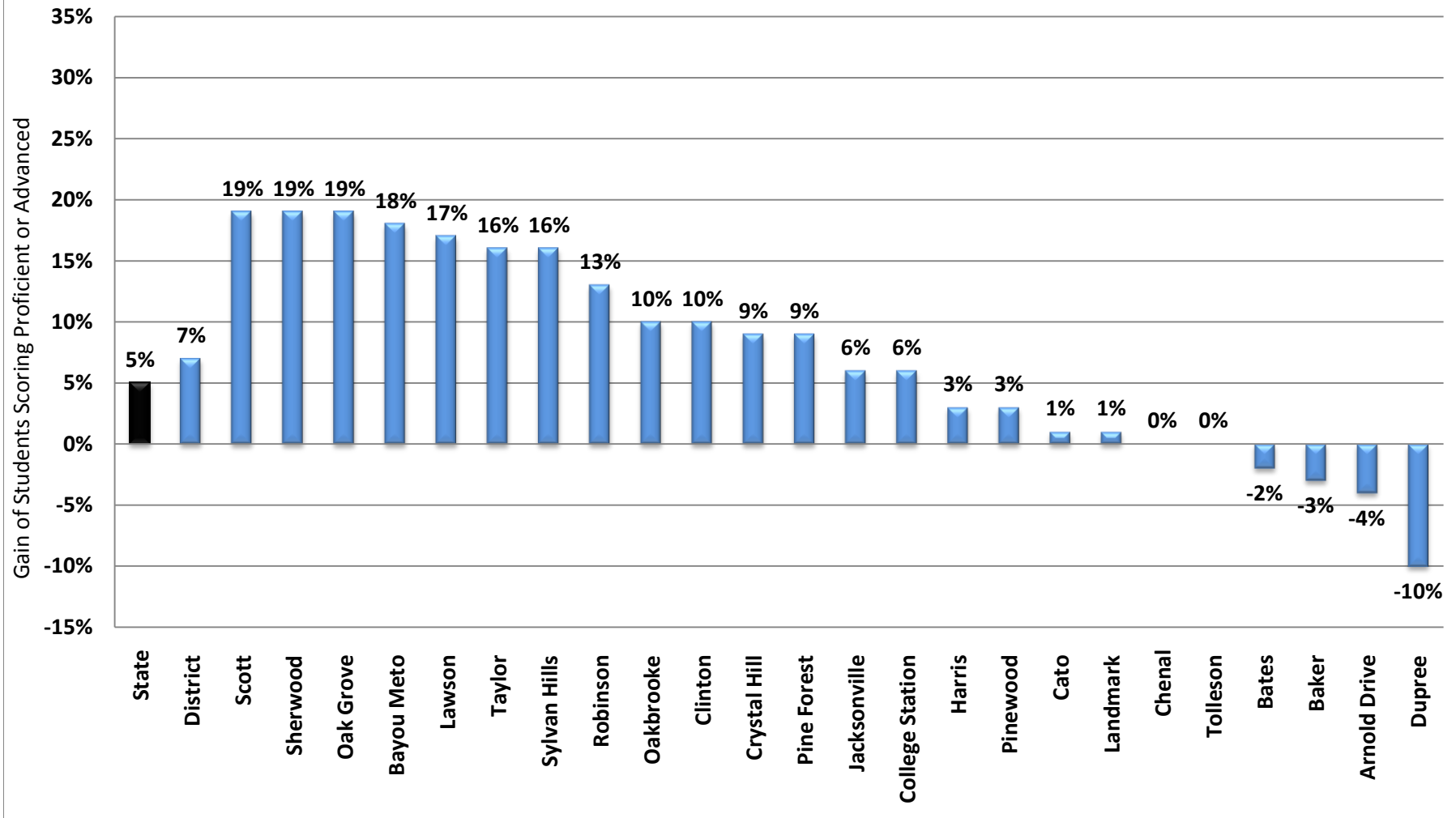

PCSSD Comparisons of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced 4th Grade Literacy Combined Population Spring 2011



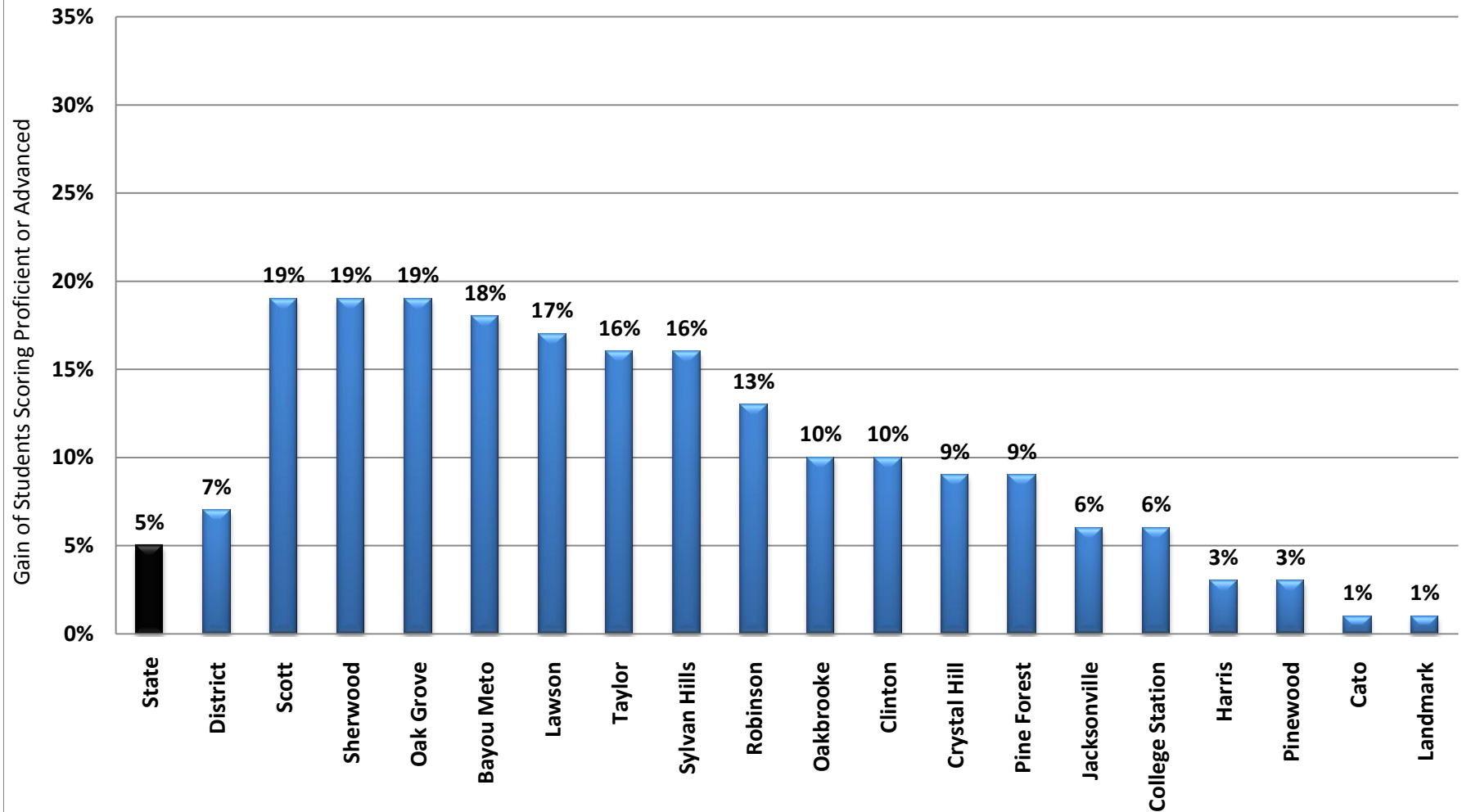

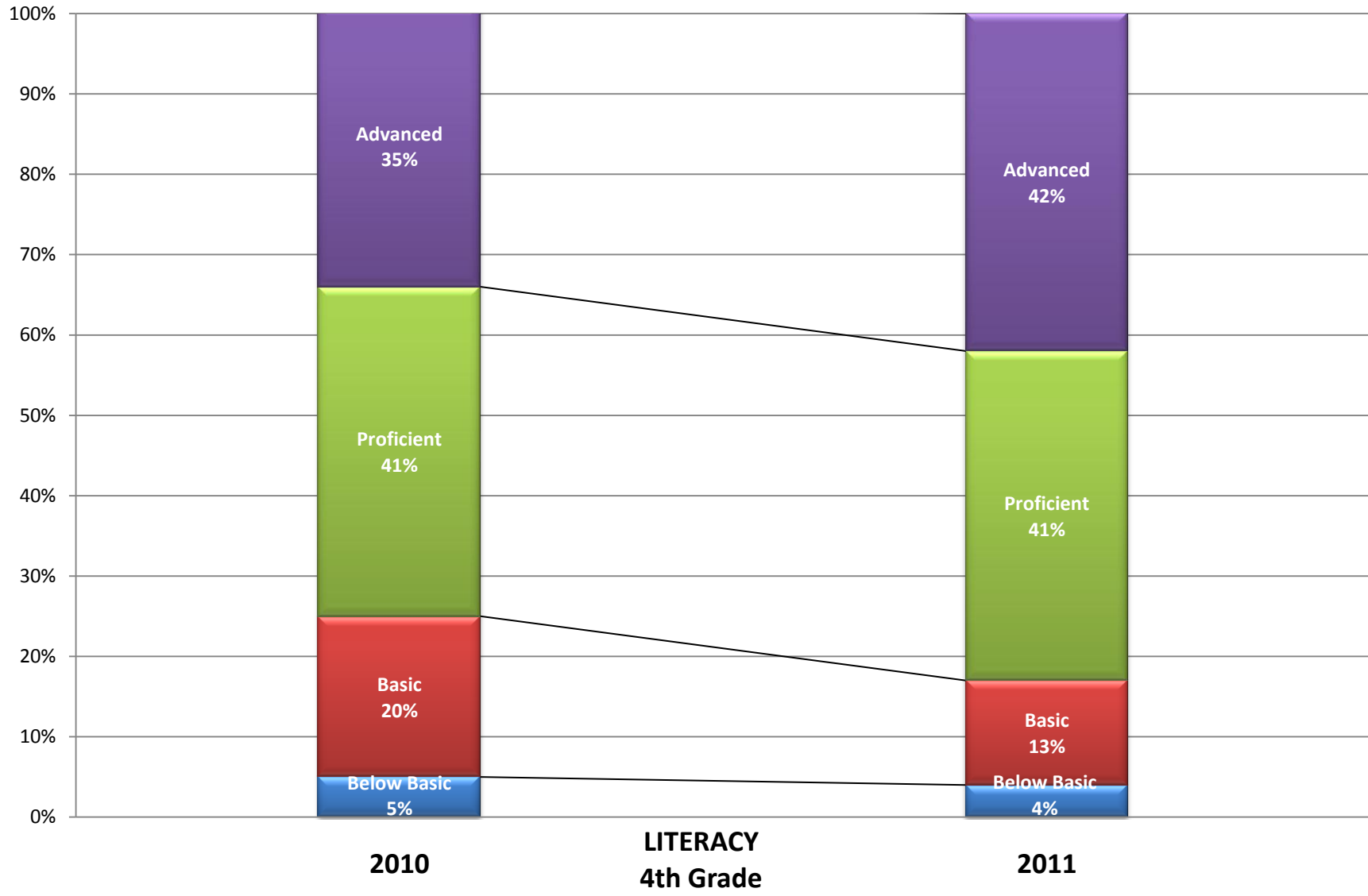
